Late Pick-Up

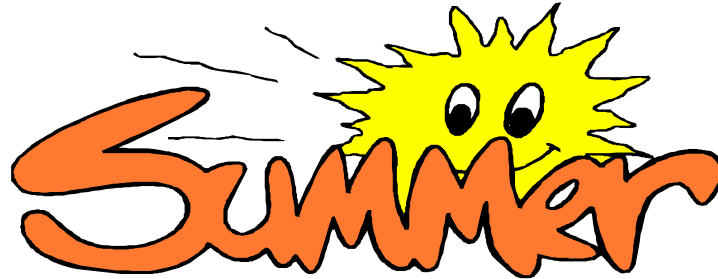

ALL children are required to take all of their required shots. This is not a Mt. Hebron requirement, but a State Requirement. Please adhere to this mandatory requirement. Those parents who are informed each month, please remember your child will not be accepted without a new Immunization Card.
