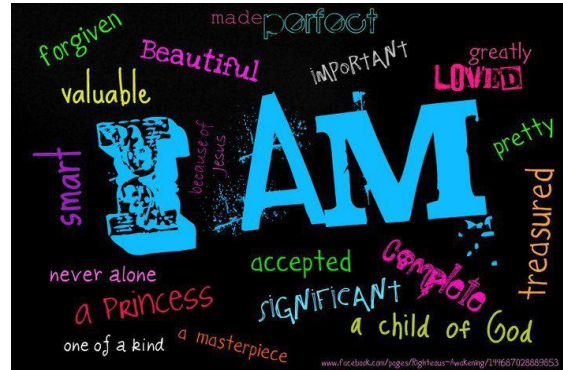

## Check-In Procedures & Additional Information

### Check in Procedures:

For your child's safety, campers must be checked in and out each day by their parent/guardian. Please enter the building using the Multipurpose entrance. Due to the pandemic, all campers will have a staggered time.

8:00 – 8:30: 7- and 8-year-olds
